VIŽULA ARCHAEOLOGICAL PARK

The archaeological remains, both terrestrial and submerged, of the archaeological park of Vižula in Istria ranges from the Neolithic to Late Antiquity and the Early Middle Ages. The most significant find in Vižula is the remains of an ancient villa, which with its impressive dimensions, monumental architecture and rich decoration, beautiful mosaics is one of the most attractive maritime residential villas from the period of the Roman Empire on the eastern Adriatic coast. Visitors can obtain all the necessary information at the infopoint at the entrance and rent VR/AR googles to enjoy the visualisation of restored ancient villa. The archaeological park was realised within the project "Preparation and Implementation of Integrated Development Programmes Based on the Restoration of Cultural Heritage", funded from the European Regional Development Fund in 2016.
